Valdawn was an exceptionally influential female. She was purchased in 1999 and continued to breed well until being sold as a 12 year old. She produced 5 sons that sold to commercial breeders, topping at \$7,000 and averaging \$3,600. Her total progeny sales amount to almost \$20,000. Valdawn had one heifer retained and we continue to use embryos that were collected prior to her leaving. She was such an important female as her male calves were always very correct, large, robust and saleable.
